The Second Lenten Banner

This banner displays wheat, which is made into bread, and grapes, which are made into wine. They are the simple earthly means which together with God's Word convey to us His body and blood. He recognizes each of us personally as His own dear child cleansed from sin by His blood, and each of us receives Christ personally into his or her own heart.
