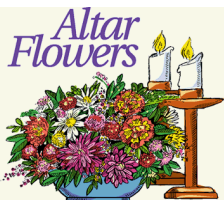

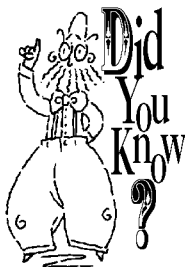

LENTEN BANNERS (On the south Sanctuary wall)

Lenten banners will take us this Lenten Season on the pathway of our Lord's passion. The first Lenten Banner depicts Jesus in Jerusalem. The Color purple symbolizes royalty, that Jesus is King of all Kings; the color violet means the "pathway" on the banner, and is also the seasonal color for Lent. It is a call to repentance. The palm branch reminds us of the paradox of joyous shouts of "Hosanna" from the crowd as Jesus entered Jerusalem, and the shouts of "Crucify Him" a few days later. Because our flesh is weak, we succumb to sin for which our Lord laid down his life. It is ever important that we "follow the violet pathway" through our life.
