About worship: The Holy Thursday and Good Friday services have no benedictions in them. This is by design as the Holy Thursday and Good Friday services are to be thought of as one service over two days. The benediction for these services is in the Easter Vigil which is a service that is to be observed either after sundown Holy Saturday or before sunrise Easter Sunday. Since we do not observe the Vigil at Immanuel the choir is offering the benediction during the prelude this morning to conclude the Holy Thursday and Good Friday observances. Thus this morning, as every day, will begin and end with the Lord's blessing (Numbers 6:22-27).
