About Worship: During Lent we fast from our praises to God in order to focus our devotion on repentance over our sins. During Easter the fast is lifted in order to focus our devotion on Jesus' victory that grants us forgiveness and eternal life. In order to do this during Lent we fasted from the Hymn of Praise that comes right before the Collect of the Day (prayer of the day). Now in Easter that hymn of praise has returned that we may sing to our risen King. Mark Maxey will be leading us in singing "He Is Lord" as the hymn of praise for today. The hymn of praise on other Sundays is "This Is the Feast" and "Glory to God in the Highest." Both the focus of Lent and Easter are necessary for our life of faith before God (Mark 1:14-15).
