



Page 17 Article IV

Currently Reads:

SEC. III SECRETARY

The Secretary shall be present at all Voter's Assembly meetings and at all Church Council meetings. The Secretary shall keep records for attendance and accurate minutes of the meetings of the Voter's Assembly and Church Council for permanent record of the congregation. The Secretary shall also be the official custodian of the congregation's constitution, corporate seal, and all legal and official documents in the custody of the congregation.

Amend tor read:

Sec. III SECRETARY

The secretary shall be present at all Voters' Assembly meetings and at all Church Council meetings. The Secretary shall keep records for attendance and accurate minutes of the meetings of the Voter's Assembly and Church Council for permanent record of the congregation. The Secretary shall maintain a current list of all voting members and make it available at all Voter's Meetings. The Secretary shall also be the official custodian of the congregation's constitution, corporate seal, and all logeal and official documents in the custody of the congregation.

Proposed Change to Immanuel Lutheran Church Bylaws

Page 11 Article II Section IV- Order of Business

SEC. III VOTING MEMBERS

1. Reception

Eligible communicant members of the congregation as defined in Article IV of the Constitution become Voting Members when they reach age 18 by unanimous vote of the voters present at a regular meeting of the Voter's Assembly provided they have read and signed the Constitution.

The Constitution in Article IV Section C describes the eligibility and procedure of those wishing to become voting members. The proposed change to the bylaws would bring them into agreement with the constitution.

After amended would read:

1. Reception

Eligible communicant members of the congregation of at least 18 years of ago who have applied for voting membership to the Pastor or Board of Lay Ministry will be given a copy of the Church Constitution and Bylaws which they must read. At the next quarterly Voter's Assembly applicants' names will be presented to the Voters' Assembly for acceptance. After the applications receive a majority vote and sign the constitution they will become a voting member.

Proposed change to Immanuel Lutheran Church Bylaws

Page 9 Section II Communicant Members 2 Termination

Currently reads:

B. Release

Upon the recommendation of the Board of Lay-Ministry and the Pastor, the Voter's Assembly may grant a peaceful release to a communicant member who wishes to join other than a Lutheran congregation.

C. Excommunication and Self-Exclusion

Upon the recommendation of the Board of Lay Ministry, and the Pastor, the Voter's Assembly may terminate communicant membership by reason of un-Christian conduct, after such proper admonition.

The names of members whose whereabouts are unknown and which cannot be established and those who fail to respond to repeated attempts to reclaim them for the church shall be excommunicated by reason of self-exclusion by a unanimous vote of the Voter's Assembly. Persons excommunicated shall be placed under the concern of the Board of Evangelism.

Proposed amendment to read:

B. Release

Upon the recommendation of the Board of Lay-Ministry and the Pastor, the Voters' Assembly may grant a peaceful release to a communicant member who wishes to join other than a Lutheran congregation as well as the names of members whose whereabouts are unknown and which cannot be established.

C. Removal

<u>Upon the recommendation of the Board of Lay-Ministry and the Pastor, the Voters'</u>
<u>Assembly may remove a communicant member whose whereabouts are unknown and cannot be established.</u>

D. Excommunication and Self-Exclusion

<u>Upon the recommendation of the Board of Lay Ministry, and the Pastor, the Voters'</u>
<u>Assembly may terminate communicant membership by reason of un-Christian conduct,</u> after such proper admonition.

Members who fail to respond to repeated attempts to reclaim them for the church shall be excommunicated by reason of self-exclusion by a unanimous vote of the Voters'

Assembly. Persons excommunicated shall be placed under the concern of the Board of Evangelism.

Note: We have 142 voting members. We would need 48 members for a quorum.
