# THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER

May 5, 2019

**\*Please stand as you are able**

On Worship: There is a prayer following This Is the Feast which is called the "Collect of the Day." "Collect" is an odd word to call a prayer. Why not call it the "Prayer of the Day"? Collect (pronounced COL-lect) comes from the ancient practice of the congregation praying until everyone was present. In ancient times they did not have timepieces like we do today. For those of you who have been to central American or Caribbean countries, you are aware of how they pay attention to time. The ancients were similar, so in the ancient church those members of the congregation who gathered for Divine Service first prayed until all were present. Then the pastor greeted them with the Salutation and led them in a prayer that collected all of their prayers plus the themes of the readings for that particular Sunday. Hence the word "collect." The Kyrie and Gloria were added later.
