On worship: the *ordinaries* are the parts of the service that stay the same for the most part from Sunday to Sunday. I have said before that they are mainly for the children of the congregation. The parts of the service that change from Sunday to Sunday are the readings, the hymns, and the sermon. These parts are called *propers*. They are called that because they are proper to the particular Sunday on which they occur. While children can get something out of these parts of the service, because they change they are more for adults who are better able follow ideas from Sunday to Sunday.




