Today's Mission Speaker David Coe, M.Div., Ph.D.
Assistant Professor of Theology and Philosophy
Department of Theology, Philosophy, and Biblical Languages
Concordia University, Nebraska



MISSIONARY SPEAKER

The school that grew to become Concordia University, Nebraska opened its doors on Nov. 18, 1894, with one professor, a dozen male students and a three-year high school curriculum. Concordia has since grown into a fully accredited, coeducational university that has granted degrees to

tens of thousands of students. Concordia is an excellent academic and Christ-centered community equipping men and women for lives of learning, service, and leadership in the church and world. According to *U.S. News and World Report*, Concordia, Nebraska is the highest-ranked of the eight other Concordia Universities, and Concordia, Nebraska educates and graduates more professional church workers for the LCMS than any other Concordia. Rev. Dr. David Coe just finished his second year as Assistant Professor of Theology and Philosophy at Concordia and has been blessed to have Samuel Smith as a student both years. Dr. Coe's 1-year-old son is named "Samuel," and Dr. Coe hopes his son Samuel will grow up to have Samuel Smith's God-given gifts of kindness, insight, critical thinking, and love for his Lord.
