On worship: There are times when the Divine Service departs from the norm. Many Vacation Bible School curricula do not acknowledge the Lord's body and blood in the Sacrament of the Altar even though they are there (Matthew 26:26-28; Mark 14:22-24; Luke 22:19-20; 1Corinthians 11:23-25). As a result they are not concerned about the altar where the Lord appears to us and feeds us. That means that VBS set designs are not conducive to celebrating the Sacrament of the Altar. However, the Board of Lay Ministry, the Board of Education, and myself felt it appropriate that today in honor of Vacation Bible School and Michael's last day that we would leave the set pieces up for the congregation to appreciate the hard work that the Board of Education put into Vacation Bible School this year.
