On Worship: The Gradual appears in between the Old Testament Reading and the Epistle Reading. In Latin the word "Gradual" means "step" hence its meaning in English. The reason it is between the Old Testament Reading and the Epistle reading is to give the congregation some section of the Scripture to pray (usually from the Psalms) while one reader who read the Old Testament reading leaves the lectern and another reader approaches the lectern to read the Epistle reading. At Immanuel we have only one reader who does both the Old Testament and the Epistle readings, but we keep the Gradual in order to hear more of the Word of God during Divine Service.
