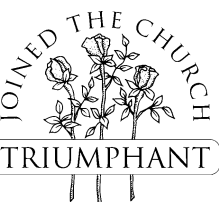


The Youth Group will give a presentation on their mission trip after the playground equipment installation and then serve lunch with a free will offering on Sunday July 23rd.
