**\*Please stand as you are able**

On Worship: One last word on the ordinaries. (Remember ordinaries are those parts of the worship service that do not change from Sunday to Sunday for the most part.) Ordinaries draw attention to the parts of the service that do change (called propers). Since ordinaries are the same every Sunday, they make the parts of the service that change more interesting by comparison. This draws attention to the parts that change and highlights them. Thus ordinaries serve to highlight the hymns, the readings, and the sermon, which are the Word of God (Colossians 3:16).
