On Worship: The final hymn is entitled *There is a Balm in Gilead*. The last time this hymn was sung at Immanuel, many of you asked the Board of Worship what "balm" was. Balm is an ointment that soothes skin irritation. Gilead is the area east of the Jordan in Israel in Old Testament times. It was a source of balm at that time. The reference in the hymn is to Jeremiah 8:22 where he laments that there is no balm in Gilead which will heal the sins of Israel. The hymn then confesses that there is balm in Gilead and that balm is Jesus.

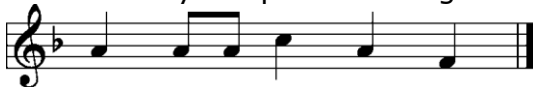

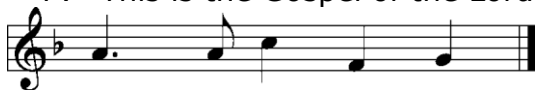

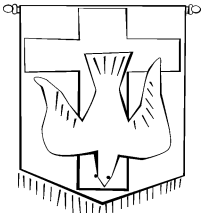
