On Worship: The rubrics for Divine Service include postures. Sometimes we stand. Sometimes we sit. While God does not command these postures the Church observes them as people are able to observe them in order to assist the worshipper in understanding what is going on in that part of the service. When we stand we are doing so either out of respect for what is happening or for praise to God or to pray to Him. When we sit we are doing so mainly to receive instruction or for some other practical purpose (like giving the offering to the Lord or waiting to be dismissed to the altar to receive the Lord's body and blood.)
