On Worship: Jesus has granted pastors the vocation to do what He has called them to do (Ephesians 4:11). Jesus has also granted to fathers to do what they do (Ephesians 6:1-4; Colossians 3:20-21). When a pastor becomes a father it is difficult for him to distinguish between the two callings. My son will learn the catechism from me as his father and his pastor. He will also listen to me administer the Word of God in the Divine Service like every other member of the congregation. But I thought that at his baptism a distinction could be made where I honor the holy office of father and lay aside the holy office of pastor at least for a moment in his life and so I have asked another Pastor Rockenbach to administer Nathan's baptism so that I may stand there like all other fathers of the congregation and watch my child be baptized and simply receive the gift.
