On Worship: When a cross appears that has legs that are the same length it looks like a plus sign +. Its proper name is a Greek Cross. Whenever the Greek Cross appears in the hymnal or on the screens the congregation is invited to make the sign of the cross. This is done by touching one's forehead, then the navel, then one shoulder, then the other shoulder. While many think this is papist or Catholic, in the Small Catechism Luther also invites us to make this sign at our morning and evening devotions.
