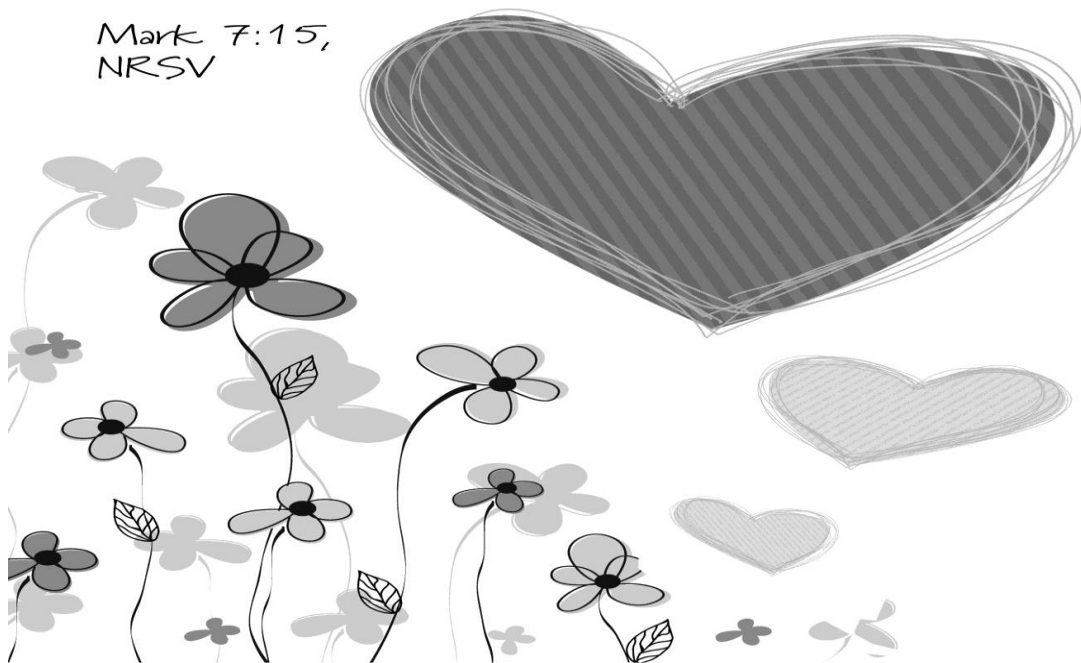

**\*Please stand as you are able**

On worship: I have recently been asked why the congregation prays the Lord's Prayer twice when there is a baptism. Baptism makes one a son of God whether the person being baptized is male or female (Galatians 3:26-28). The reason is that people are baptized into Christ and Christ is the Son of God. As a son of God the baptizand (person being baptized) has the right to call God "Father." Therefore during the baptismal service we pray the Lord's prayer together with the baptizand in order give to the prayer to the baptizand to pray for the rest of his or her life. Then later in the service we pray the Lord's Prayer together as a congregation as we do according to our Lord's instructions (Luke 11:2-4).
