On Worship: I have discussed in these worship comments before about readings from the Scripture that while reading a certain number of verses skip over some verses in between. Today's Old Testament reading is like that. From Numbers 11:4 to 11:29, verses 7-9 and 17-23 are omitted. There are a variety of reasons why the lectionary does this, but for today's reading from Numbers it is simply to keep the reading from becoming too long. While occasionally long readings are prescribed (like the Gospel reading on Palm Sunday) the people who put together our lectionary are respectful of the fact that children are at the Divine Service and that shorter sections of the Scripture may be preferred in some cases.
