On Worship: The Divine Service takes us through the life of Christ every time we celebrate it. It does it in so a subtle a way that even life long Christians sometimes do not notice. Pay attention this Sunday to the Sanctus. Are those not the words from Palm Sunday? Then comes the Words of our Lord. Are they not the words He spoke on Holy Thursday? Then comes the Agnus Dei. Is that not a description of what our Lord is on Good Friday? That leaves the distribution of the Sacrament of the Altar to be Easter Sunday where you greet the risen Christ in bread and wine in a similar way to how the women greeted our Lord on Easter morning.
