On Worship: the Ordinaries (parts of the liturgy that repeat themselves for the most part whenever any particular order of worship is used) are there to teach young children the faith. Repetition is the best teaching technique for young children. Thus when the Ordinaries are sung or spoken the congregation is teaching the faith to its own children. This also gives children access to worship so that they may participate along with the older children and adults.

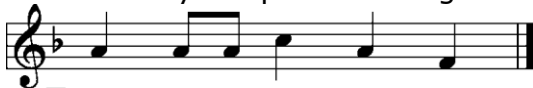
