Sunday, October 30th we will hold a Voters Assembly. This will be after church in the sanctuary. The budget for 2017 will be voted on as well as other church business.

Motion to amend the bylaws on page 9, section 2, number 2 **TERMINATION**, Letter D. **Excommunication and Self-Exclusion**, to read: (The underlined part would be added and struck thru will be removed. The rest is already in the constitution.)

D. Excommunication and Self-Exclusion

Upon the recommendation of the Board of Lay-Ministry and the Pastor, after proper admonition, by a unanimous vote the Voters' Assembly may terminate communicant membership (excommunicate) for the cause of unrepented sin.

Members who fail to respond to repeated attempts to reclaim them for the church shall may be removed by reason of self-exclusion by a unanimous vote of the Voters' Assembly. Persons thus removed shall be referred to the Board of Evangelism.

Note: This motion will bring the bylaws in line with the districts guidelines. We need at least one third of all voting members to be present for a quorum for this vote.
