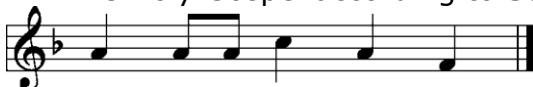

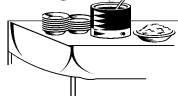

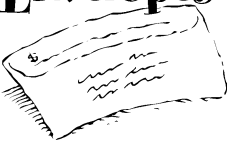

At the voters meeting we indicated we would be looking to update the car provided to Pastor. The plan was to spend only the amount currently in the car fund. That has been accomplished; a 2015 silver Chevy Impala with 15,960 miles was purchased. The 2005 Saturn was used as a trade-in. The final price for the Impala with titled and license was \$13,000. There was just over \$15,000. in the car fund account, we spend \$13000.
