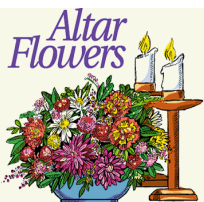

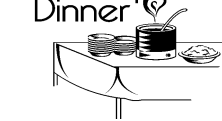

MISSIONARY SPEAKER

Rev Joshua Theilen is Executive Director of Camp CILCA and Assistant Pastor at Good Shepherd Lutheran Church in Sherman, IL. He is married to Rebekah, who he met and married at CILCA. Together they have 5 children: Ethan (14), Elianna (11), Judah (9), John (7), and Joshua (5). Pastor Theilen was previously pastor of Trinity Lutheran Church in Hoyleton, IL where he served from 2008-2016. He has been serving the LCMS congregations of Central Illinois at CILCA since February of 2016. Camp CILCA (Central Illinois Lutheran Camp Association) was founded in 1948 and began its first camping programs in 1950. Since that time CILCA has served Central Illinois as a place where God's people can disconnect from the demands of modern life and re-connect to God's Word, God's creation, and God's people. The summer program, retreats, camp outs, outdoor education, and other events give opportunity to engage the creation in meaningful ways. Camp CILCA also operates two year-round retreat facilities that are available for congregations, schools, groups, and families to rent for gatherings, reunions, and retreats.
