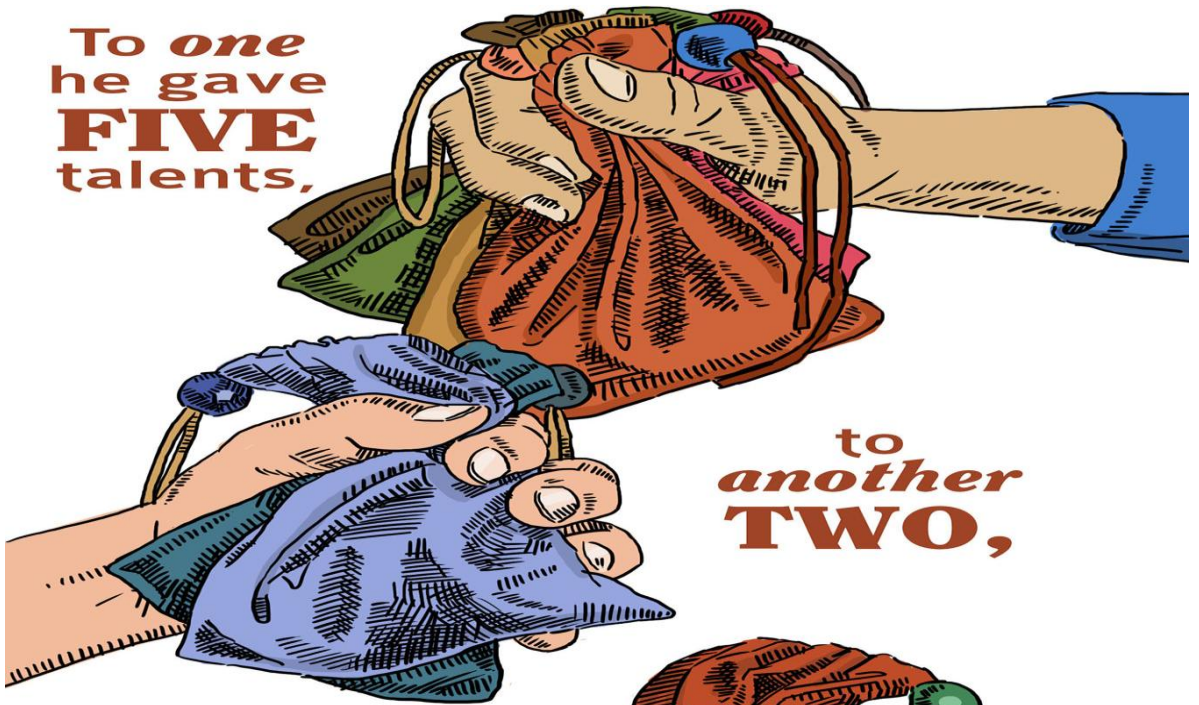

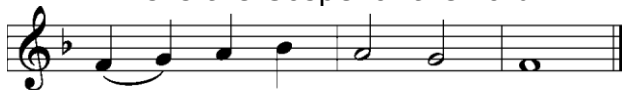

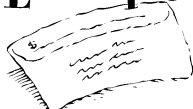
Flowers gracing the altar this morning are given joyous celebration of the 56th wedding anniversary of Willard and Elizabeth Rothermel.
