# Jay Hageman

FAIRMOUNT — Jay A. Hageman, 66, of rural Fairmount passed away at 5:38 p.m. Tuesday (Oct. 9, 2018) following an accident in rural Vermilion County.

He was born Jan. 30, 1952, in Danville, the son of Joseph and Dolores Messman Hageman. He married Tracy Miller on Nov. 24, 1974, in Sidell. She survives.
