# **Gesila Heide Zumkeller Mohr**

On June 2, 2011 Gisela Heide Zumkeller Mohr, a former Homer Illinois resident, died at her home in Ewa Beach Hawaii after a short battle with brain cancer.

Born in Carlsfeld, Germany Feb 22, 1945 to Lisbeth and Johannes Zumkeller. She was an only child. After high school, Gisela attended the Berlitz school of language and became fluent in five languages. In 1966 she moved to the United States where she worked on the family farm.
